In 1957, the British production company Hammer Films produced The first of its seven Dracula films. The first of these was The Curse of Frankenstein, which focused more on the Gothic aspects of the story than the previous films. The film was a success, leading to a sequel, The Revenge of Frankenstein, and a third, The Blood-Drinking Countess. The series continued with The Vampire Lovers, The Vampire's Kiss, and The Vampire's Wife. The Hammer Dracula films were produced between 1958 and 1974. This series of films is considered one of the most influential in the history of vampire cinema.
