ment play. The variant is &#127815; also offered by some online venues, althoug

h it is not as popular as other variants such as seven-card stud and &#127815;

&lt;p&gt;In casino play the first betting round begins with the player to the le

ft of &#127815; the big blind, and subsequent rounds begin with the player to t

he dealer&#39;s left. Home games typically use an ante; &#127815; the first bet

ting round begins with the player to the dealer&#39;s left, and the second round

begins with the player &#127815; who opened the first round.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Play begins with each player being dealt five cards, one at a time, all

face down. &#127815; The remaining deck is placed aside, often protected by pl

acing a chip or other marker on it. Players pick up &#127815; the cards and hol

d them in their hands, being careful to keep them concealed from the other playe

rs, then a &#127815; round of betting occurs.[1]&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;If more than one player remains after the first round, the &quot;draw&q

uot; phase begins. Each player specifies &#127815; how many of their cards they

wish to replace and discards them. The deck is retrieved, and each player is &#

127815; dealt in turn from the deck the same number of cards they discarded so

that each player again has five &#127815; cards.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;A second &quot;after the draw&quot; betting round occurs beginning with

the player to the dealer&#39;s left or else beginning with &#127815; the playe

r who opened the first round (the latter is common when antes are used instead o) Tj T\* B

&lt;p&gt;A common &quot;house rule&quot; in some places is that a player may not

replace more than &#127815; three cards, unless they draw four cards while kee

ping an ace (or wild card). This rule is useful for low-stakes &#127815; social

games where many players will stay for the draw, and will help avoid depletion
