<p>Lodden Thinks is a proposition betting game that was invented</p>
<p>at the World Series of 7 , £ Poker Europe by poker pros Phil Laak and Antonio Esfandiari in</p>
<p>the mid-2000s. According to Laak, the game was the 7 , £ product of boredom. As the two</p>
<p>played together at a feature televised table, they found themselves repeating the same</p>
<p>old 7 , £ tired cliched banter to one another. Esfandiari told Laak we need to come up with</p>
<p>new material. Laak thought about 7 , £ it for a bit, and he came up with an idea. He'd come</p>
<p>up with a question for Johnny Lodden, 7 , £ another popular poker professional who was at the</p>
<p>table with them, and then Laak and Esfandiari would bet on what 7 , £ Lodden would think the</p>
<p>answer was. The actual answer to the question was irrelevant. Nobody needed to look it</p>
<p>up 7 , £ or check it. In fact, the harder an answer was to check, the better, because it</p>
<p>lessened the possibility that 7 , £ Lodden would know the actual answer and would have to</p>
<p>draw upon some other knowledge or information to come up 7 , £ with a guess. Before long the</p>
<p>two were having more fun playing Lodden Thinks than playing poker, and the game</p>
<p>7 , £ caught on at tournaments and poker tables around the world.</p>
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<p>The rules are simple. First</p>
<p>you come up with a question 7 , £ with a numerical answer. The more obscure and difficult to</p>
<p>know, the better. Then the two people involved in the 7 , £ bet then hold an over/under</p>
<p>auction. One person suggests a number they think the Lodden , in this case a third</p>
<p>7 , £ person who is not involved in the bet, will answer. The other per
