<p>To clarify, vehicles with registration numbers ending in 1, 3-5 and 7; and 9 are allowed on odd days in Delhi while vehicles with registration numbers ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 are allowed on even days. Although the odd-even rule applies to all vehicles, two-wheelers and rickshaws are exempt from the scheme.</p><p>As of 1st April 2024, the Delhi government has implemented the odd-even system for private vehicles. The last digit of the vehicle number determines the days it can be driven. For example, vehicles with odd-numbered last digits (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) can only be driven on odd-numbered days (1, 3, 5, 7, 9), while vehicles with even-numbered last digits (0, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10) can only be driven on even-numbered days (2, 4, 6, 8, 10).</p><p>Delhi pollution: What is the odd-even rule?...
