Fees for PayPal Deposits and Withdrawals

PayPal fees at online casinos can seem confusing at first. However, we break down the fees you may encounter across while playing here so that you have all the information you need in one place.

**PayPal Casino Site Fees**

To discuss fees, we need to bear in mind the difference between the fees charged by PayPal for deposits and withdrawals, and those charged by the casino site. From the PayPal side, deposits are usually free, but this varies from site to site. Some may charge a deposit fee, but this is rare. For withdrawals, many casinos do not charge any fees either when you use PayPal, although you may find exceptions.

**PayPal Deposit Fees**

In the US, PayPal will not charge you anything when you're using your existing account balance or an electronic funds transfer from a bank account. When you deposit cash as a personal payment via debit or credit card, there is a 2.9% fee + R\$0.30 of the total amount sent.

**PayPal Withdrawals Fees**

When it comes to withdrawals, charges may apply depending on where you withdraw your PayPal funds to. Once you have your casino winnings in your PayPal account, you can choose to send them to a bank account or debit card, two of the most preferred options for withdrawals. Depending on your location, PayPal does not charge a fee to transfer funds to your linked bank account. This applies, for example, to Australia and bank accounts in AUD. To send money to a USD-denominated bank account, there's a fee of 2.5% of the transfer value.

**PayPal Currency Conversion Fees**

If you need to convert the currency of your funds to do this, currency conversion fees will apply, too. For debit card withdrawals, you'll pay a fee of 2% of the value of the withdrawal, with minimum and maximum amounts.
