

# golden roulette

What are the odds in roulette? The odds of winning a round depend on the number of outcomes covered in the bet. If you bet on a single number, you are facing 1 to 35 odds.

For example, if you bet on a single number and win, you receive 35 times your bet plus your original bet. The house edge is 2.7%.

Probability: 1/37 for a single number bet, 18/37 for a double number bet, 12/37 for a triple number bet, 6/37 for a four number bet, 3/37 for a five number bet, and 1/37 for a six number bet.

Example:

You bet \$10 on the number 17. If you win, you receive \$350 plus your \$10 bet.

Another example: If you bet \$100 on a double number (17 and 18), you receive \$180 plus your \$100 bet (for a 2 to 1 payout).

If you bet \$100 on a triple number (17, 18, and 19), you receive \$240 plus your \$100 bet.

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
