The player immediately clockwise 🌻 from the small blind posts the " big blind", which is typic ally twice the size of the small blind (blinds can 🌻 vary depending on) Tj T* BT /F

the same as 🌻 the small bet, and the small blind is typically half the size of the big blind (but may be larger 🌻 depending on the stakes). F or example, in aR\$2/\$4 Limit game the small blind isR\$1 and the big blind isR\$2.
