Red Rake Gaming adds to its interesting lineup of mythology-based slots with Medusa Hunt. The game replays an epic battle in which the female monster is defeated by a strong prince. Unlike the myth, there is a potential win of 1,065x up for grabs here. In this Medusa Hunt review, you can find answers to all your questions about the slot's features and how to win.

Slot Features

Medusa Hunt takes place on a 5x3 slot grid. Adopting the common Betways mechanic, players can land winning combinations on 25 paylines in the slot. It offers quite a good win potential due to an advertised jackpot of 1,065x the stake. However, the volatility is medium, and the RTP is below industry standard (95.3%).

Although the grid in Medusa Hunt consists of only five reels, it does not prevent the studio from integrating unique mechanics. The slot uses the sticky wins feature. It means that all symbols that create a winning combination remain in their positions for a respin. If additional winning symbols appear on the reels during that respin, they stick to their places and a new spin is granted. Moreover, there is a multiplier metre that increases by x1 after every successful respin.

There are two special symbols in Medusa Hunt by Red Rake, though neither hits all that often. The Medusa herself acts as a Wild and can substitute anything except the Bonus symbol. Strangely enough, she's one of the rarest Wilds we've ever seen. You could spin the reels dozens of times and not see her appear once. It's even stranger if you consider she's the game's title character.

The Medusa Hunt bonus symbol triggers a free spin mode if you have 3 of them anywhere on the table. Medusa Hunt free spins don't have much special about them, though. You just get 10 pins you don't have to pay for, and re-triggering is not possible unless you hit 3 Bonus symbols again. &
