Inside Bets these are indi vidual O, £ numbers or combinations of numbers and have normal payouts of betwee n 35:1 to 5:1. It is these bets that multipliers O, £ will be paid on, and also the bets that have their normal payouts reduced (which pays for the multipliers) .</p&gt; <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;The outside 0, £ bets play as they do on a regular European Roulette ta ble, so there is no harm in playing those bets 0, £ on the Super Spin table, you Il get the same return.</p&gt; <p&qt;&lt;/p&qt; <p&gt;The implications of playing the Inside bets and the impact the O, £ mul tipliers have on the payouts does need some explanation.</p&gt; <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;Inside Bets&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;Straight Up Bet This is a bet where your chip covers 0, £ one number o n the betting grid. There are thirty-seven numbers to choose from. You can place as many straight-up bets 0, £ as you like. The multiplier payout will be for th e full amount. Payout = Straight-up Bet amount x Multiplier.</p&gt; <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;Split Bet 0, £ This is a bet where your chip covers two numbers S0 half the amount is on one number O, £ and half on the other. You cover two numbe rs with one bet. The multiplier payout for a Split bet is 0, £ half. Payout = Sp lit-Bet amount x multiplier divided by two.</p&gt; <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;Street Bet Your chip covers three numbers across the betting O, £ gri d. There are 12 rows to place bets on. The multiplier payout for a Steet Bet is a third. Payout O , £ = Street Bet amount x Multiplier divided by three.</p&gt <p&gt;&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;Corner/Basket bet This is a bet where you place your chip O, £ on the intersection where 4 numbers meet. Hence the corner. The multiplier payout for

a Corner bet is a quarter. O, £ Payout = Corner Bet Amount x multiplier divided by four.&lt:/p&gt:
