06th October 2012 Atletico-GO vs Vasco da Gama (Serie A Brazil)
Atletico-GO are having a terrible season and find themselves at the foot of the table after 27 games. As you would expect, they have scored the least goals in the league with 27 whilst also having the worst defensive record, conceding 48. That doesn't make for good reason if your a GO supporter.
As you might expect from a team at the bottom of the league, their recent run of form is also the worst in the league. They only managing 1 win and 1 draw in their last 6 games, however, their single win did come away from home against league leaders Fluminense, where they managed to take a 2-0 lead before the break and held on to win the game 2-1.
This was indeed a shock result so they are capable of pulling something out of the bag from time to time.
Their home form, like their current form, is also the worst in the league managing to only pick up 3 wins and 3 draws from 13 games.
